

Municipal Notice of Intent

TAKE NOTICE that on June 12, 2018, the council of the Rural Municipality of St. Clements gave first reading to bylaw 13-2018 to designate as a municipal heritage site under *The Heritage Resources Act*, the lands and premises commonly known as St. Jude's Church, 14 Grey Avenue in Grand Marais.
